REFLECTION

Today's readings shout out LOVE, God's love for us and God's invitation for us to love one another. Today is also Mother's Day and who better to teach us love than a loving mother? The message of Mother's Day is a message of love across borders, just as God's love crosses borders. Let us recall the original Mother's Day Proclamation of 1870 which affirms in a very profound way this universal lesson. In that Proclamation, Julia Ward Howe wrote: "Arise, then, women of this day! Arise all women who have hearts, whether your baptism be of water or of tears! Say firmly: '...Our sons shall not be taken from us to unlearn all that we have been able to teach them of charity, mercy, and patience. We women of one country will be too tender to those of another country to allow our sons to be trained to injure theirs.' From the bosom of a devastated Earth a voice goes up with our own. It says 'Disarm! Disarm!' ...take counsel with each other as to the means whereby the great human family can live in peace....to promote the alliance of the different nationalities, the amicable settlement of international questions, and the great and general interests of peace."

REFLEXIÓN

Las lecturas de hoy gritan AMOR, el amor de Dios por nosotros y la invitación de Dios para que nos amemos unos a otros. Hoy también es el Día de la Madre y ¿quién mejor para enseñarnos el amor que una madre amorosa? El mensaje del Día de la Madre es un mensaje de amor a través de fronteras, así como el amor de Dios cruza fronteras. Recordemos la Proclamación original del Día de la Madre de 1870, que afirma de manera muy profunda esta lección universal. En esa Proclamación, Julia Ward Howe escribió: "¡Levántense, entonces, mujeres de este día! ¡Levántense todas las mujeres que tienen corazón, sea su bautismo de agua o de lágrimas! Di con firmeza: "... Nuestros hijos no nos serán quitados para desaprender todo lo que hemos podido enseñarles sobre la caridad, la misericordia y la paciencia". Nosotras, las mujeres de un país, seremos demasiado tiernas con las de otro país como para permitir que nuestros hijos sean entrenados para dañar a los suyos". Desde el seno de una Tierra devastada se eleva una voz con la nuestra. Dice "¡Desarmar! ¡Desarmar! '... consultarnos unos con otros sobre los medios por los cuales la gran familia humana puede vivir en paz ... para promover la alianza de las diferentes nacionalidades, la solución amistosa de las cuestiones internacionales y los grandes intereses generales de la paz. . "

- Install an elevator to Kiernan Hall

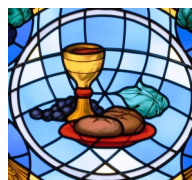
