REFLECTION

Sunday's readings begin with a beautiful image of God creating man and gifting him with all kinds of creatures so he wouldn't be alone. But even more beautiful is God's realization that animals don't adequately fulfill man's need for a partner, one not made of the earth, but of the same flesh and blood of which man is made. The readings end equally beautifully with Jesus welcoming children whom some wanted to keep from him. Instead, he insists that we must be like children to enter God's kingdom, and he blesses them. The difficulty in Sunday's readings comes in the middle where we hear Jesus's strict teaching about divorce. To modern ears, that can be very painful, but we mustn't forget the context. God does not want us to be alone. God does not want us to be easily dismissed. God does not want us to be superior one over another, male over female, adult over child. God does want us to be in communion with each other; to be accepted and respected; to be as simple, vulnerable, and trusting as children. These readings are not so much about the prohibition of divorce as they are about God's great desire for us to be loved. Let's live in that love and celebrate it together.

REFLEXIÓN

Las lecturas del domingo comienzan con una hermosa imagen de Dios creando al hombre y dándole todo tipo de criaturas para que no esté solo. Pero aún más hermoso es la comprensión de Dios de que los animales no satisfacen adecuadamente la necesidad del hombre de una pareja, una que no esté hecha de la tierra, sino de la misma carne y sangre de la que está hecho el hombre. Las lecturas terminan igualmente hermosamente con Jesús dando la bienvenida a los niños que algunos querían ocultarle. En cambio, insiste en que debemos ser como niños para entrar en el reino de Dios y los bendice. La dificultad en las lecturas del domingo viene en el medio donde escuchamos la estricta enseñanza de Jesús sobre el divorcio. Para los oídos modernos, eso puede ser muy doloroso, pero no debemos olvidar el contexto. Dios no quiere que estemos solos. Dios no quiere que seamos despedidos fácilmente. Dios no quiere que seamos superiores unos a otros, hombres sobre mujeres, adultos sobre niños. Dios quiere que estemos en comunión unos con otros; ser aceptado y respetado; ser tan sencillos, vulnerables y confiados como los niños. Estas lecturas no tratan tanto sobre la prohibición del divorcio como sobre el gran deseo de Dios de que seamos amados. Vivamos en ese amor y celebremos juntos.

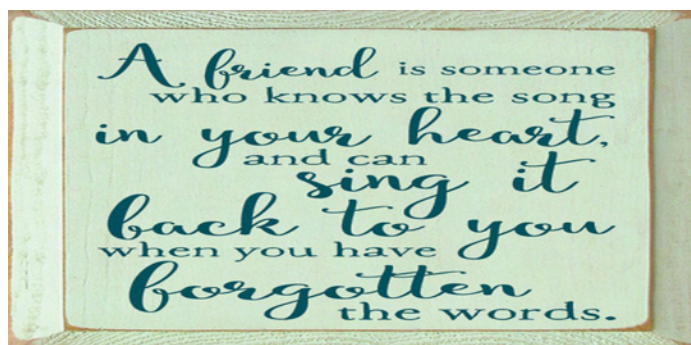

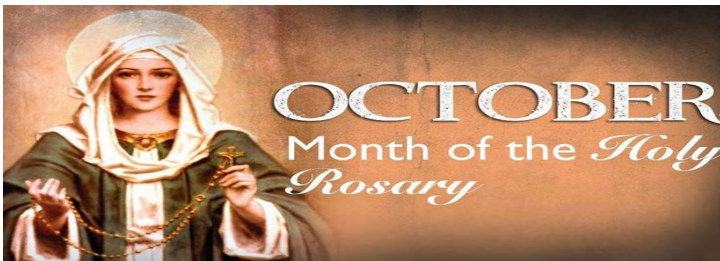
