REFLECTION

What a spectacular liturgy is this Sunday's liturgy! It takes us through so many emotions from the glory of Jesus's entry into Jerusalem, welcomed with praise and honor, to the extreme stress of the Last Supper and Agony in the Garden to the abandonment by friends and followers to the injustice of a trial that leads to the release of a known murderer and the conviction of an innocent man to the ridicule of soldiers, and the excruciating physical pain of crucifixion. It's almost too much to absorb. And yet there is more. In the midst of such fear and torture, Jesus still feeds his companions with bread and wine that is his body and blood. He continues to teach—about service and mercy, healing the soldier whom his own disciple has injured. He comforts the women and forgives his enemies. Jesus endures the unendurable so as to model for us what it truly means to love God, our neighbors, and our enemies devoid of violence or vengeance. We hear this story so often, it's easy to become immune to the enormity of its message, but this is what it means to call ourselves Christian, to be Christ-like. Let us never become complacent in the presence of such greatness!

REFLEXIÓN

¡Qué liturgia tan espectacular es la liturgia de este domingo! Nos lleva a través de tantas emociones desde la gloria de la entrada de Jesús en Jerusalén, acogida con alabanza y honor, al estrés extremo de la Última Cena y la Agonía en el Huerto, al abandono de amigos y seguidores a la injusticia de un juicio que lleva a la liberación de un asesino conocido y la condena de un hombre inocente al ridículo de los soldados, y al dolor físico insoportable de la crucifixión. Es casi demasiado para absorber. Y aún hay más. En medio de tanto miedo y tortura, Jesús todavía alimenta a sus compañeros con pan y vino que es su cuerpo y sangre. Continúa enseñando sobre el servicio y la misericordia, curando al soldado herido por su propio discípulo. Consuela a las mujeres y perdona a sus enemigos. Jesús soporta lo insoportable para modelarnos lo que realmente significa amar a Dios, a nuestro prójimo y a nuestros enemigos sin violencia ni venganza. Escuchamos esta historia con tanta frecuencia que es fácil volverse inmune a la grandeza de su mensaje, pero esto es lo que significa llamarnos cristianos, ser como Cristo. ¡Nunca nos volvamos complacientes ante tanta grandeza!
