REFLECTION

Take those feelings and magnify them a thousand times. Only then might we come close to the extraordinariness of God's gift to us in the Resurrection. Let's pray for the ability to know the awe of this magnificent day all the way to the core of our being, so that we can truly be an Easter people for one another throughout the entire year.

REFLEXIÓN

Tal vez nos ayudaría pensar en experiencias mucho más familiares que hayamos tenido y que nos hayan llevado a sentimientos similares. ¿Cómo es cuando pensamos que alguien a quien amamos profundamente se ha ido para siempre, totalmente derrotado, y él o ella regresa a casa? ¿Qué se siente cuando estamos seguros de que un ser querido se ha perdido en una tormenta mortal, un accidente o un asalto violento y descubrimos que escapó con vida y bien? Toma esos sentimientos y multiplícalos por mil. Solo entonces podremos acercarnos a lo extraordinario del don de Dios para nosotros en la Resurrección. Oremos por la capacidad de conocer el asombro de este magnífico día hasta el centro de nuestro ser, para que podamos ser verdaderamente un pueblo de Pascua unos para otros durante todo el año.

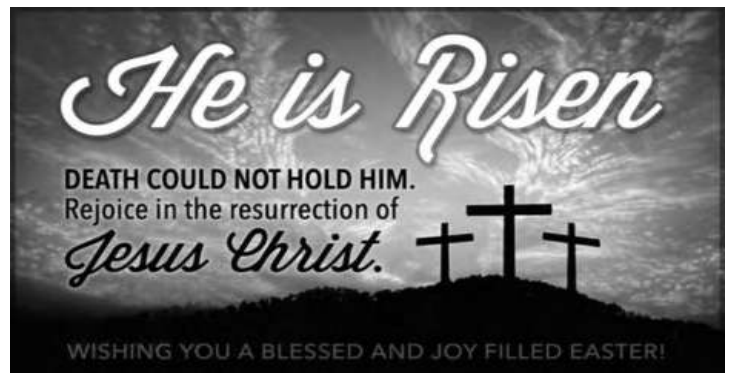

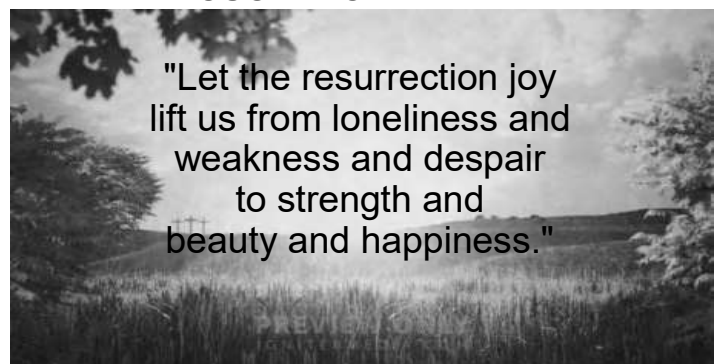
