REFLECTION

Sunday's Gospel is a proclamation of unity, Trinitarian unity and unity between the Trinity and us, but what about unity among us? It seems common knowledge and acceptance that we are divided as a nation and among nations. The political divide literally keeps former friends and families apart. We feel it's better to avoid one another than to come together and end up fighting. We're even divided on Church matters.

What can we do? As usual, the answer lies in love. Jesus says to his Abba God, "I made known to them your name and I will make it known, that the love with which you loved me may be in them and I in them." It's certainly not easy to set aside our differences, and both Stephen and Jesus died because they would not compromise on what they knew was of God, but we can still seek unity through a shared love of God. We can strive to listen to one another, to care for one another, to recognize points of agreement, to respect points of disagreement, to refuse to be drawn into silence or complicity or violence, and to remember God's love for all of us regardless of who we are. If God can love us, can we not love in return?

REFLEXIÓN

El Evangelio del domingo es un anuncio de unidad, unidad trinitaria y unidad entre la Trinidad y nosotros, pero ¿y la unidad entre nosotros? Parece de conocimiento común y aceptación que estamos divididos como nación y entre naciones. La división política literalmente mantiene separados a antiguos amigos y familiares. Sentimos que es mejor evitarnos unos a otros que unirnos y terminar peleando. Incluso estamos divididos en asuntos de la Iglesia.

¿Qué podemos hacer? Como siempre, la respuesta está en el amor. Jesús le dice a su Abba Dios: "Les he dado a conocer tu nombre y se lo daré a conocer, para que el amor con que me amaste esté en ellos y yo en ellos". Ciertamente no es fácil dejar de lado nuestras diferencias, y tanto Esteban como Jesús murieron porque no transigieron en lo que sabían que era de Dios, pero aún podemos buscar la unidad a través de un amor compartido de Dios. Podemos esforzarnos por escucharnos unos a otros, cuidarnos unos a otros, reconocer puntos de acuerdo, respetar los puntos de desacuerdo, negarse a dejarse llevar por el silencio, la complicidad o la violencia, y recordar el amor de Dios por todos nosotros, independientemente de quiénes seamos. Si Dios puede amarnos, ¿no podemos corresponder al amor?
