Confessions At Parish House anytime. Make an appointment by calling 718-680-1010 during office hours. Also before or after any Mass.

Eucharist for the Homebound Eucharistic Ministers are available to bring communion to the homebound. Call the Parish House to make arrangements.

For emergencies and to make arrangements for sick calls, wakes or funerals, call the Parish House at any time.

REFLECTION

We live in an era when many people seem loath to make a commitment whether in small matters or large. People don't want to commit to social gatherings any more than they want to commit to business appointments; yet, Sunday's readings have much to say about making commitments. Elijah is calling Elisha to make a commitment as a prophet. Jesus is telling those who claim to want to follow him that they will have to commit unconditionally to the point of sacrifice. He's not too patient with those who offer excuses. At the same time, Sunday's readings refer to freedom more than once. Both Elijah and Jesus allow for commitments freely chosen. Chances are they knew full well that a commitment made under duress is not likely to hold. Are we willing to commit freely and unconditionally to God's call to us—to love our neighbors as ourselves, to be guided by the Spirit, as St. Paul writes, and to embrace the nonviolence that Jesus practiced toward the unwelcoming Samaritans when James and John wanted to "call down fire from heaven to consume them"?

Vivimos en una era en la que muchas personas parecen reacias a comprometerse, ya sea en asuntos pequeños o grandes. La gente no quiere comprometerse con reuniones sociales más de lo que quiere comprometerse con citas de negocios; sin embargo, las lecturas del domingo tienen mucho que decir acerca de hacer compromisos. Elías está llamando a Eliseo para que se comprometa como profeta. Jesús les está diciendo a aquellos que dicen querer seguirlo que tendrán que comprometerse incondicionalmente hasta el punto del sacrificio. No es demasiado paciente con los que ofrecen excusas. Al mismo tiempo, las lecturas del domingo se refieren a la libertad más de una vez. Tanto Elías como Jesús permiten compromisos elegidos libremente. Lo más probable es que supieran muy bien que un compromiso hecho bajo coacción no es probable que se cumpla. ¿Estamos dispuestos a comprometernos libre e incondicionalmente con el llamado de Dios para nosotros: amar a nuestro prójimo como a nosotros mismos, ser guiados por el Espíritu, como escribe San Pablo, y abrazar la no violencia que Jesús practicó hacia los samaritanos que no les daban la bienvenida cuando Santiago y Juan ¿Querían "hacer descender fuego del cielo para consumirlos"?
