## DID YOU KNOW

### YOU CAN HELP ST. ANDREW'S WITH YOUR IRA?

The IRA charitable distributions provisions permit an individual who has reached the age of 70½ to make a distribution from an IRA or an individual retirement annuity (not a SEP, simple retirement account or inherited IRA) to a qualified charity without treating the distribution as taxable income. Additionally, the distribution to charity will satisfy the required minimum distribution [RMD] rules. Making a charitable gift from an IRA is more efficient than receiving the IRA distribution and then using it to make the gift. If you receive the IRA distribution, you must include it in adjusted gross income. This can increase the tax on your Social Security benefits and medical insurance premiums can increase. For more information about the IRA charitable distributions provisions, contact your IRA custodian. Additionally, regardless of your age, consider naming St. Andrew's as the beneficiary of all or part of your retirement plan.
